ILLINOIS SNAPSHOT OF EARLY LITERACY - 2009-10 Scores

The Illinois Snapshot of Early Literacy (ISEL-K/1) is a comprehensive kindergarten and first grade, classroom-based reading inventory. The ISEL-K/1, administered to all public school kindergarten and first grade students in the state of Illinois, is based on scientific reading research and reflects the National Standards for Reading. Norms are based on an educational-geographic cross-section of 1,000 Illinois students. The Test is divided into ten sections, or "snapshots." In the spring, snapshots 1-6 are administered to kindergarten students.

Snapshot 2 - Story Listening Comprehension
Snapshot 3 - Phonemic Awareness
Snapshot 4 - One-to-One Match

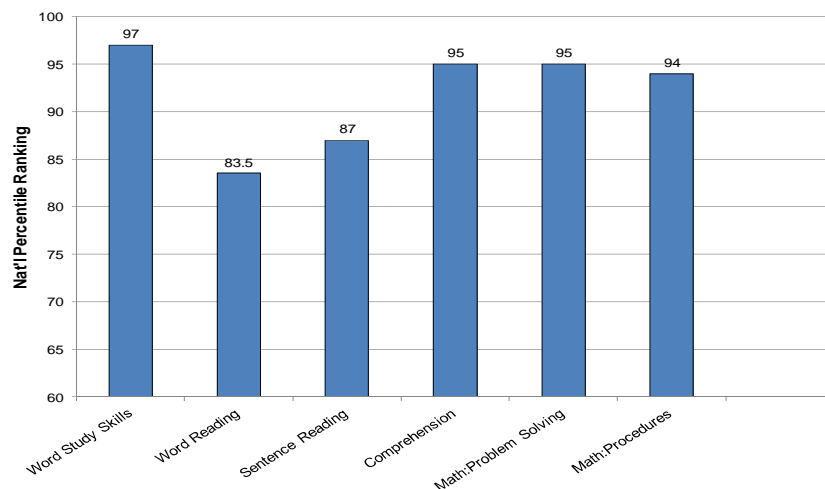

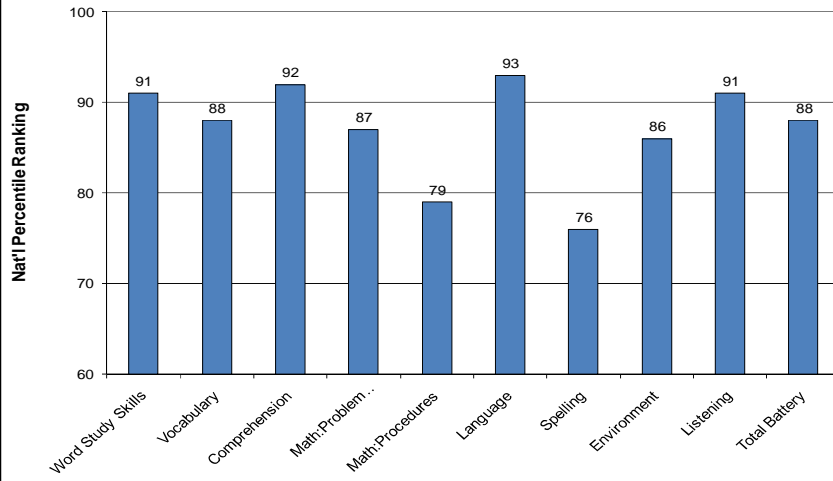
STANFORD ACHIEVEMENT TEST (10th Edition) 2009-10 Scores

The following charts present the overall median scores by grade level of WCGS students compared to students in the same grade level across the nation. The Total Battery score provides an overall indication of this group's performance.

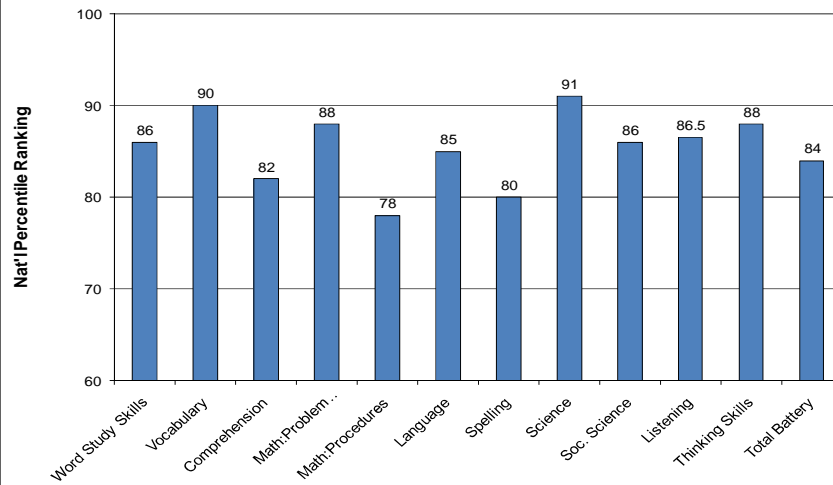
First Grade



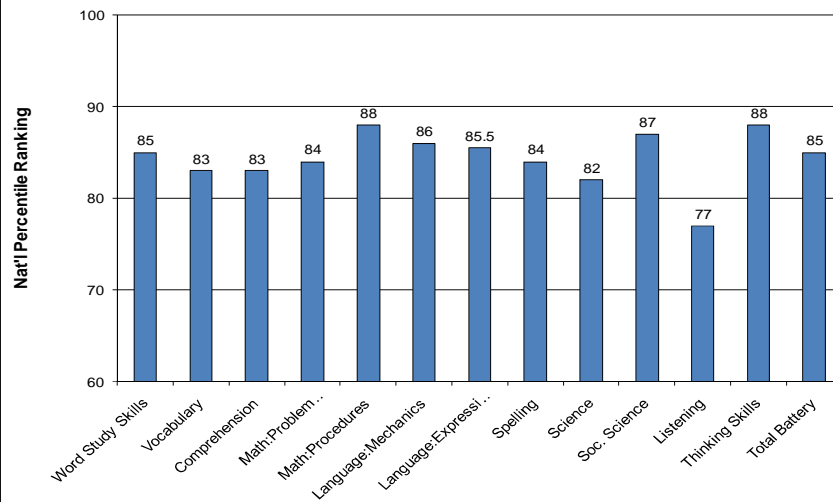
Second Grade



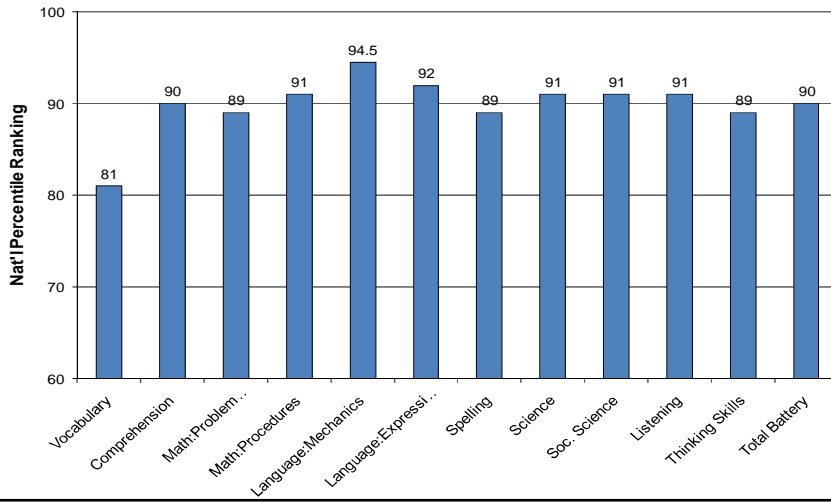

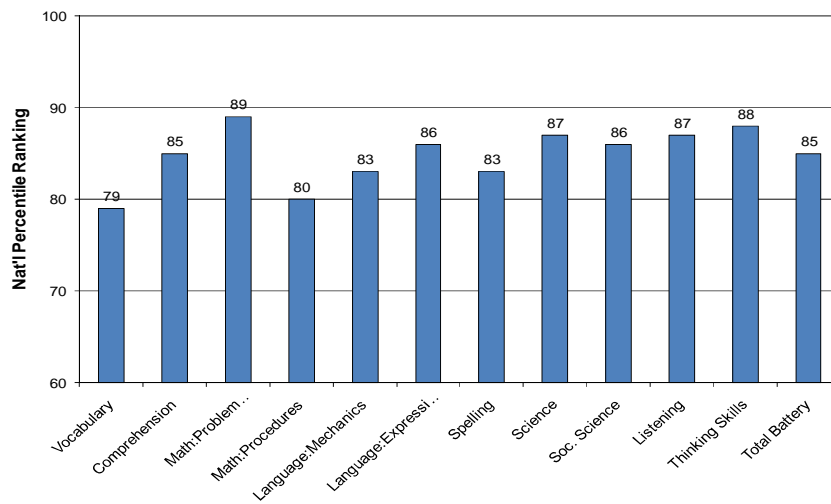

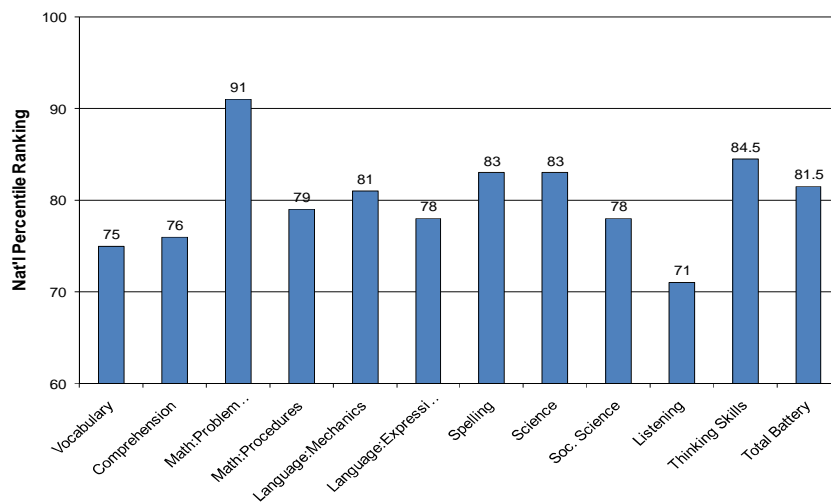

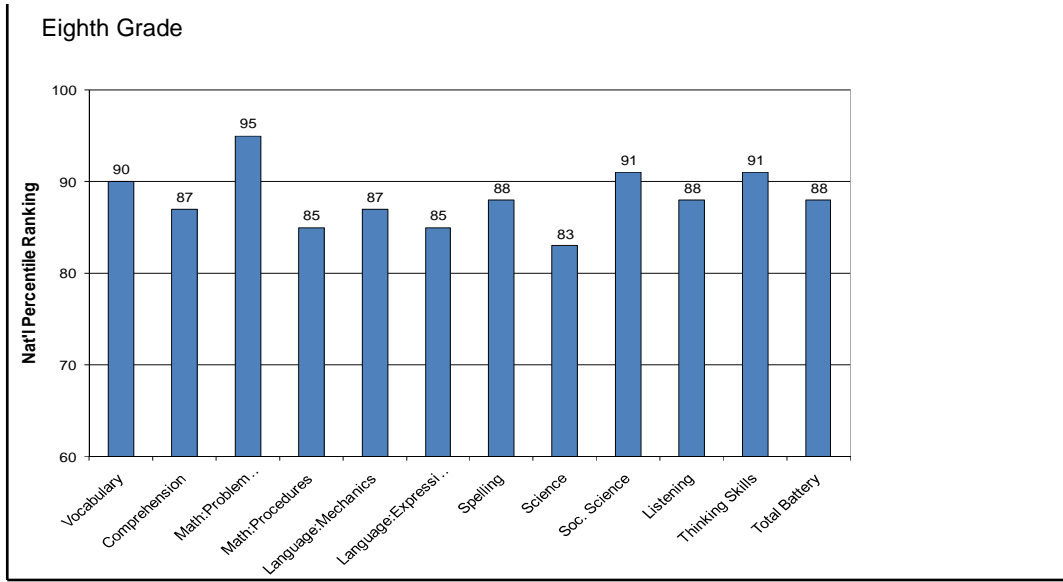


Sixth Grade
